



3 DAYS ON THE PA ROUTE 6 ARTISAN TRAIL – Endless and Pocono Mountains

This is a point to point trip heading east through Bradford, Wyoming, Lackawanna and Wayne Counties. To start this trip, we recommend starting Route 6 off of US Route 15 (I-99)

Day 1: Mansfield to Tunkhannock

As you travel east on Route 6, stop at the **Settlement House Fine Arts in Sylvania** (MM 246-247) to discover the talents of Connie Sickler and several other local artisans. Continue on Route 6 to the town of Towanda and a visit to the **Keystone Theater** (MM 272-273) . If it is a Saturday in the summer, you can take a short detour off of Route 6 to the **Home Textile Museum** (MM 275) in Rome for a demonstration of traditional skills use in the production of fabrics for everyday use. Back on Route 6 East, head towards Wyalusing (MM 286) for a good lunch and a visit the special exhibits at the **Blue Heron Art Gallery**. You can pick up a copy of the self-guided “**Quilted Corners of Wyalusing**” driving tour – a great way to spend a few hours while enjoying the area’s landscape. While driving around, make your way to the **LeRaysville Cheese Factory** (MM 287) for some yummy treats. The last stop for the day is Tunkhannock (MM 311-312) , where you can find local artisans on display at **the Endless Mountains Council of the Arts**. Spend the evening exploring this community, enjoy a great dinner at **Twigs Restaurant**, catch a show at the **Dietrich Theater** and relax for the night at the **Comfort Inn and Suites**.

Day 2: Tunkhannock to Carbondale

Start the day off with a short detour off of Route 6 up Route 11 North to the 100-year old **Tunkhannock Viaduct** (MM 320) before making you way into the heart of Scranton (MM 332). There are many interesting cultural and historical offerings in Scranton from **Steamtown National Historic Site** to the **Electric City Trolley Museum**. Stroll the streets of the historic downtown, making a stop to see the works of local and regional artists at the **AFA Gallery**. Also check out the schedule for events at **Crow Design Studio**. Be sure to visit sculptures depicting the life of a coal miner at the **Pennsylvania Anthracite Heritage Museum**. Then travel on to Carbondale (MM 343-345) for the evening and a stay at the **Best Western Pioneer Plaza**.

Day 3: Carbondale to Matamoras

Spend the morning, exploring the walking tour of Carbondale before heading to Honesdale (MM 359-360) for a tour of the collections at the **Wayne County Historical Museum**. The museum will give you a taste of the talents of Christian Dorflinger, to learn more about the famed glassmaker and see his factory, visit the **Dorflinger Glass Museum** in White Mills. Next stop is the Hawley (MM 368-369) for a relaxing lunch near **Lake Wallenpaupack**. The art district of Milford (MM 394) will make a great afternoon activity. Before leaving Route 6, make sure to visit the amazing sculptures honoring each of the American conflicts and wars at **Veterans Park** in Matamoras (MM 400).
